## CRITERIA FOR: "Councils of Distinction" Award

### **DIRECTIONS:**

Utilizing a hard copy (scrapbook) type of format, or utilizing the current computer technology, create a "power point" presentation or CD-Rom or DVD presentation (no longer than 20 minutes) that follows the below mentioned prescribed guidelines. Provide and creatively organize the evidence, data, and documentation to support your Student Council's entry to be honored as a "Council of Distinction". Evidence may be from the 2009-2010 school year as well as 2010-2011 school year. Those entries that exceed the prescribed guidelines as outlined in this form will be honored as an "Outstanding Council of Distinction". All entries that meet the deadline date and follow the guidelines will be honored. Both these recognitions will be awarded at the annual AASC State Convention. If at all possible the entry submitted should reflect your Student Council's work during the school year previous to when the award is given out. Deadline for submitting entries will be 60 days before the convening of the upcoming AASC State Convention. Good Luck!
