INFORMATION REGARDING APPLICATION TO RUN FOR AASC ADULT EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER

Dear Student Council Advisors,

The AASC Executive Board is made of three elected student officers and six adult student council advisors. Each year two of the six adult advisors that sit on the AASC Executive Board terms expire. As a result, at each of the AASC State Conventions, an election must be held to fill these positions. In accordance with the AASC Charter, there are actually two methods by which an Advisor from an AASC Member school may seek these Executive Board positions.

Method #1:

Any current Student Council Advisor from any AASC Member School may complete the application and send it in to the AASC Executive Director by the deadline date and they will automatically be placed on the ballot at the AASC State Convention.

Method #2:

Any current Student Council Advisor from any AASC Member School may seek the position of Adult Executive Board Member, and pick up a nominating petition from the AASC Directors at the start of the annual AASC State Convention. (Thursday evening) and then secure the signatures of thirty (30) Student Council Advisors who are at the convention and then submit the petition to the AASC Directors at the beginning of the Advisor Luncheon on Friday of the State Convention. Once this has occurred, the Advisor who completed the petition will be placed on the ballot along with any other Advisors who completed Method #1.

If you are interested in seeing the position of AASC Adult Executive Board Member and are a current Student Council Advisor from an AASC Member School and decide to use Method #1, fill out the below application and send it in by the deadline date indicated. If you decide to use Method #2, you can pick up a nominating petition at the registration tables upon arrival at the annual AASC State Convention. Please see either of the AASC Directors/
